## *Dance Photos ~ on-line ordering*

Your dance photos are available again this year as digital images that you download to your computer. These are colour-corrected, high quality files suitable for printing (see "Printing Tips").

### **Your step-by-step guide to (relatively) glitch-free on-line ordering**

- Your photos will be available for viewing and purchase about two to five days after each photo session.
- Go to **sgsmithphoto.instaproofs.com**
- Click on "TK Danceworx 2019"
- Enter your email address and the password "dance"
- The photos are arranged by day, and category (Individuals, Class Groups).
- To purchase photos, select "Hi-Res Digital Image" and add to cart.
- After making all of your selections, proceed to checkout.
- Use the **discount code b9e8dd4f65** for discounts on orders for two or more photos.
- **Download** your photos to your computer.

### **Big Discounts for Big Orders** (*buy more, save more!*)

The price for a single, high-resolution image is \$15.00 + HST, but...

- Order 2 or more and the cost (at checkout) is only \$13.50 each
- Order 5 or more and the price is reduced to \$12.00 each
- 10 or more: \$10.50 each / 15 or more: \$9.00 each / 20 or more: \$7.50 each

### **And Remember!**

- Use the discount code **b9e8dd4f65**
- **Download your photos to your computer after purchase.**

As always, let me know if you need to arrange another way of viewing or purchasing your photos (photos on cd, payment by cash, etc.).

### **Printing Tips: Do not "Autocorrect"**

Most photo labs use an "autocorrect" program to help compensate for under or over exposure, contrast, and colour balance. Unfortunately, these programs do not always handle extreme or unusual lighting, such as the bright white background used for the dance photos. All of the dance photos have been corrected for colour, exposure, and contrast, and should need no further corrections when printing. If you are uploading and ordering prints online, you should be able to switch this feature off. If you go directly to the lab, you can simply ask them to print the files without corrections, or "as is". (You can still choose the size and cropping that you want).

**And yes, you can still order 2018 and 2017 photos** - same password, same discount code.
